HARBOUR CRUISE – 15th JUNE

On Wednesday, 15th June, the whole school went on a free outing to see the ports of Auckland from the water.

We started by walking down to the harbour, only five minutes from the school. Even Charlie, who had had the misfortune to break his ankle (not in our school), could manage this stroll easily.

The one-hour ferry ride started near the historic Ferry Terminal Building and proceeded first to the Container Terminal, where we were able to appreciate the huge size of some of the container ships berthed there. Ships come here from all parts of the world, and the one which we examined most closely was flying a Hong Kong flag.

We turned back and passed under the Harbour Bridge, the link between the city of Auckland and the attractive beaches and residential areas which lie to the north. The bridge itself is the most famous one in New Zealand, always busy with traffic and the location of the city's Bungy Jump.

Nearby is Westhaven Marina, crowded with the sailing vessels for which Auckland, "the city of sails", is justly famous.

We returned by way of Viaduct Harbour, constructed for the defence of the America's Cup yachting trophy in 2000, and now the home of some of the city's most expensive accommodation.

Once back at Quay Street, we returned along Queen Street, the main thoroughfare of Auckland, to the school. It was a trip which everybody seemed to have enjoyed and on which a great many photographs had been taken.
