Why New Zealand Diploma In Business?

New Zealand Diploma in Business (NZDipBus) is the most widely recognised and versatile management qualification by employers and professional associations in New Zealand. It provides a broad introduction to business and relevant practical business skills with specialist papers in accounting, management, marketing, human resource management and computing.

Study Pathway:

In terms of study pathway, the diploma offers many favourable cross-crediting options for students into New Zealand and Australia major universities.

Career Opportunity:

In terms of employment, the diploma provides graduates with a sound base of knowledge and skills to function effectively in First Level and Middle Management positions and includes the opportunity to specialise in areas such as Accountancy, Management, Human Resources and Marketing.

Immigration to New Zealand:

Under the new skilled migration policy, those overseas students who completed the two years full time NZDipBus programmes, are entitled to 60 immigration points, a qualification for one of your legs into New Zealand.
